Position Summary:

North Toronto Soccer's Competitive Program consists of teams U13-U21 who participate in regional & local leagues during the indoor and outdoor seasons. This program is part of Canada Soccer's *Soccer for Life* stream and is separate from the Club's Talented Pathway Program; OPDL & League1 Ontario.

Teams train two or three times per week and play a weekly game.

Head Coaches are responsible for leading all aspects of team operations including:

- Planning & delivering training sessions
- Coaching games
- Facilitating tryouts
- Providing player feedback
- Maintaining good communication with players and families
- Regular communication with the Manager, Competitive Program
